# $80 \mathrm{~cm} \times 60 \mathrm{~cm}$ SINGLE COLOUR CHECKERED PRAM BLANKET 

 FOR Jade's BABY, JACK

## REQUIREMENTS

5 (50g) skeins Double Knit baby wool (Wendy - Peter Pan)
5.50 hook for Foundation Chain
4.00 hook for the rest of the work 8 small opened safety pins

4 pieces of coloured cotton thread
1 tapestry needle + scissors
1 tape measure, pins, dampened cloth \& spray bottle

## MAIN PIECE (Worked in rows)

72 cm long $\times 52 \mathrm{~cm}$ wide (1st rows $1-4$ start \& end in 8 miss ch pattern. There are 9 of these \& there are 7 of the 8tr together pattern). Then this pattern alternates.

## TIPS:

Do not think about using a contrasting colour for border as uneven stitches are very noticeable To finish row at edge of work, 14 lengths of wool per row are needed. (Length of row $\times 14$ )
150 g skein does 17 rows
There are 51 rows in MAIN PIECE $4 \mathbf{5 0 g}$ skeins are required to crochet main piece

FOUNDATION CHAIN - 5.50 hook Make a multiple of $16+11$

For this size pram blanket, make a ss (it does not count as first ch. Put a safety pin in it so as not to confuse it as a ch later on when forming corners. Leave it in until both MAIN PIECE \& BORDER are completed. Loosely crochet 123 ch ( $16 \times 7+11$ ) this will make the main piece of this blanket
approximately $72 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52 \mathrm{~cm}$. Hold work as it is formed between 1st finger \& thumb of left hand. DO NOT twist wool or work. It is best to do all of the foundation ch in one sitting. Put a safety pin in every 16 ch to keep count.

## FOUNDATION ROW - 4.00 hook

 Rs $=$ Right side(Rs) 1tr into 5th ch from hook, (be sure that the treble $\&$ hole match the next pattern size, as it is easy to make a mistake here).
(1ch, miss 1ch, 1tr into next ch) 3 times, there must be 5 treble $\& 4$ holes! * 1tr into each of next 8ch, (1ch, miss 1ch, 1tr into next ch) 4 times, rep from $*$ to end, turn. (2 less sts)

Proceed as follows:-

## MAIN PIECE

1st Row 4ch, (4ch counts as 1 tr $\&$ 1ch), miss 1ch sp, 1tr into next tr, (1ch, 1tr into next tr) 3 times, * 1tr into each of next 8tr, (1ch, 1tr into next tr) 4 times, rep from $*$ to end, turn.

## 2nd \& 3rd Rows As 1st row.

4th Row 3ch, (3ch counts as 1tr), * (1tr into next ch sp, 1tr into next tr)

4 times, (1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr into next) 4 times, rep from * to last 8 sts, (1tr into next ch sp, 1 tr into next tr) 4 times, turn.

5th Row 3ch, * 1tr into each of next of 8 tr , ( 1 ch , 1 tr into next tr) 4 times, rep from * to last 8 sts, 1 tr into each of next 8tr, turn.

## 6th \& 7th Rows As 5th row.

8th Row 4ch, miss 1 tr, 1 tr into next tr, (1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr into next tr) 3 times, * (1tr into next ch sp, 1tr into next tr) 4 times, (1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr into next tr) 4 tines, rep from * to end, turn.

FROM 1st - 8th row sets the pattern.

Continue until work measures approx $72 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52 \mathrm{~cm}$, ending with 3rd or 7th row of pattern. Fasten off.

BORDER (Worked in rounds)
Place a cotton coloured marker thread at each corner, then with right sides facing, using same 4.00 hook starting at a corner proceed as follows:-

1st Round 1ch (1ch counts as 1dc), work a row of dc evenly around main piece, working an extra dc (in the same hole at each side of coloured marker thread. Move marker threads to new centre of each corner.
N.B. Crochet 2dc for each (row side) \& 1dc for each (stitch side). At end
of round join last dc to top of first dc with a ss.

2nd Round 1 ch (1 ch counts as 1 dc ), work 1dc into each dc of previous round, working an extra dc (in the same hole at each side of coloured marker thread. Move marker threads to new centre of each corner. At end of round join last dc to top of first dc with a ss.
COUNT dc of all sides. Opposite sides should have the same number of dc.

3rd Round 4ch, (* miss 1dc, 1tr into next dc, 1ch, rep from * to corner,
work 4tr around corner, 1ch) do this at each corner. Join last ch to first tr with a ss. COUNT stitches of all sides. Opposite sides should have the same number of tr \& 'holes'.
N.B. - DO NOT include corner trebles when counting each side. There should be 1 less tr \& 1 more 'hole'. Move marker threads to new centre of each corner.

4th Round 1ch, 1dc into each st of previous row, working extra dc \& moving marker threads at corners as before. At end of round join last dc to first dc with a ss.

## 5th Round As 4th round. Fasten off.

## TO COMPLETE

1. Use tapestry needle to sew in ends.
2. Carefully pin out blanket to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths \& leave until dry.
3. Keep skein band for washing \& care info.
